- 2nd year language GPA of 3.0 or higher OR Ma-
jors 3.0 language GPA

BEGIN./INTERM. SPANISH: (6-9 Cr hrs)

- One semester of College level Spanish or
Equivalent
- Applicants with a GPA between 2.5 and 2.99 may
be considered on a case by case basis.
- All participants must be 19 years of age by time
of departure and have a minimum overall 2.5
GPA

Participation requirements include:

- 2 mandatory pre-departure orientations
- 1 mandatory 're-entry' session for all partici-
pants to this program;
- Participants are required to have a valid pass-
port to travel to Spain. All passports must be
valid for at least six months past the last date
of the program.
- Completion of USA and USM application docu-
ments including USA academic advising forms
(Transient Student Approval), good standing
approvals, student responsibility forms, tran-
script processing forms, official sealed copy of
USA transcript, copy of flight/travel itinerary
information if not traveling with group.
- Applicants to the program must also submit the
following to complete their application:
 - 4 recent passport-size photographs
 - USM application documents
 - A photocopy of passport

The University of South Alabama Summer Session in Madrid will be held in collaboration with the University of Southern Mississippi Madrid Program. Students participating in this program will attend the USM program hosted by ENFOREX Institutes at its center in Madrid. Classes meet in small groups led by highly qualified instructors who specialize in teaching Spanish as a foreign language. Program participants will be assigned to classes based on their academic background in Spanish. All courses emphasize communication skills and oral proficiency

PARTICIPATING FACULTY:

The program director for the 2010 USA Summer Session in Madrid will be **Dr. Federico Perez-Pineda, Associate Professor**, Foreign Languages and Literatures (Spanish) (College of Arts and Sciences). Dr. Perez-Pineda will teach the USA course in Madrid.

(3 cr) Taught in English—Dr. Doug Marshall
Explore the differences between US culture and Spanish culture/institutions.

[] LG 290 Intermediate Conv. Span. (3 cr)
Taught in Spanish by USA instructors.

Classes will be taught by USM, ENFOREX AND USA faculty. Students will be placed in the appropriate Spanish Language course level based on previous Spanish course work.

2010 ESTIMATED PROGRAM FEE:

Undergraduate: \$ 5,600*

PROGRAM FEE INCLUDES:

- USM tuition 6 cr. hrs—transient credit)
- USA Tuition 3 cr.hrs. (USA tuition/fees apply).

- Roundtrip GROUP Flight from New Orleans to Madrid
- Group airport transfers in Spain (arrival/ departure only)
- Excursions to world famous museums such as El Prado, the Museo Nacional de Arte Reina Sofia, the Thyssen-Bornemisza and the Museo de America, and walking tours to explore such historic sites as well as two full weekend excursions to other locations in Spain.

NOT INCLUDED: Personal expenses: including telephone, laundry expenses, local and other transportation, books, passports, visas (if applicable), additional health/accident insurance, medicines, etc. Some meals on weekdays and weekends. Admission fees to some venues.
