

IMPORTANT STUDENT HEALTH INFORMATION BEFORE YOU ATTEND NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

1. IMMUNIZATIONS:

- i) The University of South Alabama requires that all students born after 1956 must have had 2 doses of a measles containing vaccine (rubeola, M.R., MMR) prior to class registration. One dose must have been after 1980 and at least one of the doses must have been an MMR.
- ii) The University of South Alabama (USA) requires that all enrolling International and ESL students **MUST** provide acceptable proof of tuberculosis screening. The screening result date must be within the past six (6) months.
- iii) All students living in the residence halls must provide proof of having received immunization for bacterial meningitis within the last five (5) years.
