In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Act, the University Police are giving notice of reported crimes that occurred in the Delta and Beta Residence Hall complexes.

Notice: **Armed Robberies**

University of South Alabama Police is urging caution on campus following two late-night robberies this past weekend. Students, faculty, and staff are urged to be aware of their surroundings and be cautious late at night. The USA Police Department has heightened patrols following these incidents.

Incident 1: At approximately 3:45 a.m. on Saturday, November 7, a resident of Beta 2 residence hall reports that he heard someone knocking on his door. He opened the door and three black males entered the room. Once in the room, they pulled handguns from under their coats and demanded the resident's belongings. Stolen were two laptop computers and an iPhone. The robbers then fled the area on foot.

Incident 2: At approximately 2:45 a.m. on Monday, November 9, a resident of Delta 2 residence hall reported that as he was walking toward his vehicle, a black male grabbed him by the shoulder and pushed him up against the dumpster in the parking lot. He then noticed that a second black male walked up to the area. While the victim was against the dumpster, he felt a hard object on his back. The men demanded his wallet. When he told them he did not have a wallet he was searched. The perpetrators then ran from the area.

Descriptions of the assailants in both incidents are as follows:

Black male 5'10" with a goatee

Black male 6'2"
