

Hurricane Isaac Update: Tuesday, 6 p.m.

University of South Alabama classes remain canceled for Wednesday and the normal class schedule will resume on Thursday. In light of improving conditions in the Mobile area and the westerly movement of the storm, staff employees should report to work on Wednesday as University offices will reopen. Students residing on campus are welcomed to stay in residence halls, and food service will be provided. Students, faculty and staff should use their best judgment to make decisions based on their personal safety.

All Health Sciences Division students should follow the directives of the general University except those in clinical settings, who should follow the directives of their assigned clinical supervisors. USA's hospitals and clinics will remain open, and employees and all medical residents/fellows should report to work as usual. Hospital and clinic employees experiencing hardships should contact their supervisor.
