Internship Application

Students are required to (1) Meet with the faculty internship coordinator to discuss their internship experiences and performance, (2) Meet with the internship supervisor throughout the semester to discuss their internship experiences and performance, (3) Complete the Weekly Internship Report, (4) Complete the Internship Performance Evaluation, (5) Create and present portfolio packets of their internship work, (6) Write formal thank you notes to the internship sponsors, and (7) Register for Professional Studies: Internship (CA 496) semester of the internship.
