We seek a broadly trained scientist to teach undergraduate lecture courses in the Marine Sciences minor. Additional duties include coordinating the introductory marine sciences labs, serving as the institutional liaison representative to the Marine Environmental Sciences Consortium at the Dauphin Island Sea Lab. Minimum qualifications: a Ph.D. degree in Marine or a closely related discipline. Preference will be given to candidates with demonstrated success in teaching marine sciences classes as well as with the potential to recruit undergraduate marine science minors and to contribute to the outgrowth of the department, college, and university.
