Fall Southeastern Sectional Meeting of the American Mathematical Society, October 13 -15, at USA

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics will be hosting the Fall Southeastern Sectional Meeting of the American Mathematical Society (https://www.ams.org/meetings/sectional/2311_other.html). We are expecting more than 400 research mathematicians to come to the campus of the University of South Alabama. The conference will start on Friday, October 13, at 2 PM, and last until Sunday, October 15, noon. There are 21 parallel sessions of research talks and three invited addresses, all housed in Shelby Hall and the Mitchell College of Business. USA last hosted this conference in the nineteen eighties. Hosting a sectional meeting is a great opportunity for the University of South Alabama to present itself to the mathematical community and showcase its beautiful campus and academic programs.

The American Mathematical Society (AMS) is the professional society for mathematicians in the US. It has about 30,000 individual and 570 institutional members. It hosts the annual Joint Mathematical Meeting, typically attended by several thousand participants, and 8 Sectional Meetings per year. Two of these are in the Southeastern Section, comprised of those states south of Maryland from the East Coast to the Mississippi River and beyond, including Arkansas and Louisiana. Generally, there is one meeting in the spring and one in the fall.

As part of the program the Department of Mathematics and Statistics will host a reception on Saturday, October 14, from 6 PM until 7:30 PM, in the Globe Grand Lobby of the Mitchell Center.
