

Tenure-Track Position Mathematics

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at the University of South Alabama invites applications for a full-time (9 month), tenure-track position at the rank of assistant professor in mathematics, starting August 15, 2027. Applicants should possess an earned doctoral degree in mathematics or a closely related field. Applicants should have a strong commitment to both research and teaching. Research faculty members typically receive a reassigned course load of three classes in the fall and two classes in the spring semesters to help facilitate their on-going peer-reviewed research.

Review of applications will begin on November 6, 2026, and continue until the position is filled.

Applications should be submitted online at www.mathjobs.org, and should include a cover letter, curriculum vitae, research statement, teaching statement, and three signed letters of recommendation (at least one of which should specifically address teaching). We cannot accept applications submitted directly to department faculty.

Applicants invited for a campus interview must also arrange to have all official graduate and undergraduate transcripts sent directly by the Registrars of all colleges and universities attended to Dr. Mark Colarusso either electronically at mcolarusso@southalabama.edu or by mail at the following address:
