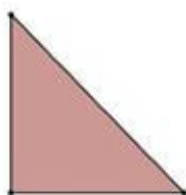

When to hold ‘em?

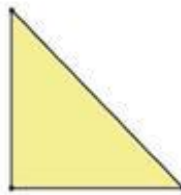

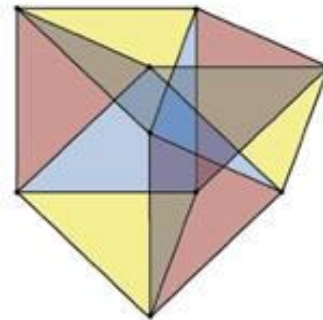
