### APPEARANCE (5 points)

**1 point.** Appearance is visually unappealing and detracts from the content. The use of colors, fonts, figures, and graphs make the poster difficult to view or understand.

**3 points.** Appearance neither contributes to nor detracts from the content. The poster is basic and does not attract interest.

**5 points.** Appearance is appealing and enhances the content. The use of colors, fonts, figures, and graphs compliments the content.

### ORIGINALITY (5 points)

**1 point.** The project concept is poorly developed.

**3 points.** The project concept is simple and straightforward.

**5 points.** The project concept is advanced and innovative.

### ORGANIZATION (5 points)

**1 point.** Ideas are disorganized and hard to follow.

**3 points.** Ideas follow a basic, direct presentation.

**5 points.** Ideas are presented for maximum clarity and effectiveness.

### CONTENT\* (10 points)

**1 point.** The poster did not fulfill the description for its category.

**5 points.** The poster satisfied the description for its category.

**10 points.** The poster fulfilled the description, exceeding expectations for its category.

### ORAL PRESENTATION/Q&A (5 points)

**1 point.** The presenter is unfamiliar with the topic.

**3 points.** The presenter has a superficial understanding of the topic.

**5 points.** The presenter is knowledgeable and conversant on the topic.

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### \*Category Descriptions

#### *Clinical and Translational Research*

*The poster focuses on traditional clinical or translational research and presents the objective, hypothesis, methods, data collection, and analysis. Reference on the poster should be made to the IRB or other approval unless the project was exempt from such approval; this should be indicated on the poster.*

#### *Quality and Performance Improvement*

*The poster demonstrates the use of the Plan-Do-Study-Act (PDSA) quality improvement tool, including the project's aim statement, the planned intervention, the metrics used in data collection during the project, the outcome analysis, and the actions implemented because of the project.*

#### *Patient Safety, Education, and Advocacy*

*The poster focuses on patient safety, covering how the project contributed to improvements in patient safety and the delivery of consistently high quality, safe care either quantitatively or qualitatively. The poster should provide evidence that the team's work has considered existing best practice. If the poster focuses on the education and/or advocacy aspect, the poster should include content from an associated patient education campaign or advocacy efforts and evidence the impact of the project on the target population's health.*
