The University of South Alabama College of Nursing /Advanced Nursing Education Nurse Practitioner Residency in Family Practice is a collaboration with USA Health and Franklin Primary Health Center. The goal of the project is to improve family nurse practitioner readiness to practice with a focus on underserved and rural areas by following the community health center model of primary care.



Application

- Applications for the 2021-2022 residency cohort are now being accepted. Six individuals will be accepted for the 2021-2022 residency, which runs July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Qualifications

- Recent graduates (within 18 months) from an accredited Master of Science in Nursing or Doctor of Nursing Practice program, licensed in Alabama and board certified as a Family Nurse Practitioner at least 60 days prior to the start of the residency.

Benefits

- The residency is a full-time, 12-month salaried position with benefits in the Mobile, AL area. The program format will include precepted sessions, specialty rotations, clinical and didactic training with opportunities for continued employment upon completion of the residency. This program will provide you the skills, experience and confidence needed to launch your career as a primary care provider.
