The University of South Alabama College of Nursing /Advanced Nursing Education Nurse Practitioner Residency in Family Practice is a collaboration with USA Health and Franklin Primary Health Center. The goal of the project is to improve family nurse practitioner readiness to practice with a focus on underserved and rural areas by following the community health center model of primary care.



## Application

- Applications for the 2022-2023 residency cohort are now being accepted. Ten residents will be accepted for the 2022-2023 residency, which is July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023. Note: This residency is fully funded by HRSA and the number of residents we can accept will be contingent on the availability of funds. ## Qualifications

- Recent graduates (within 18 months) from an accredited Master of Science in Nursing program, licensed in Alabama before the start of residency, and board certified as a family nurse practitioner.

The program format will include precepted sessions, specialty rotations, independent clinics and didactic training with opportunities for continued employment upon completion of the residency. This program will provide you the skills, experience and confidence needed to launch your career as a primary care provider.
