The University of South Alabama Department of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) invites applications for a non-tenure track, twelve-month, Instructor of EMS. Candidates for this position will be expected to advise students and teach a variety of courses, including paramedic, ACLS, PALS and BLS.

Qualifications: Candidates must have a Bachelor's Degree from a regionally accredited institution (Master's Degree preferred), current State of Alabama paramedic license, National Registry paramedic certification, a minimum of three years of paramedic work experience, and at least one year of experience as an EMS instructor. Candidates with a Bachelor's degree will be required to obtain a Master's degree in a related discipline from a regionally accredited institution within four years of hire date. Candidates must also have instructor certifications in American Heart Association ACLS, PALS and BLS. Position will start August 15, 2020.

Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.
