POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES include undergraduate course instruction in recreational therapy and health related core subjects; directing student research and internship experiences; providing academic advisement; engaging in scholarly research and publication; presenting research at professional association meetings; pursuing external funding; participating in curriculum development and initiatives related to accreditation, assessment of learning outcomes, and student recruitment and retention; and engaging in professional and community service.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS include an earned doctorate in Recreational Therapy or Therapeutic Recreation; Recreation, Park, and Leisure Studies; or a closely related discipline. ABDs near completion of the degree will be considered. If the terminal degree is not in Recreational Therapy or Therapeutic Recreation, a master's degree or cognate/concentration in Recreational Therapy or Therapeutic Recreation is required. Eligibility or current credentials from the National Council on Therapeutic Recreation (NCTRC) is required. At the rank of Associate Professor, the successful candidate will have demonstrated a consistent and ongoing record of scholarship and extramural funding, and/or demonstrated experience in providing program leadership.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS include professional work experience and/or demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with diverse communities. Proficiency in at least one area in aquatic therapy, gerontology, physical rehabilitation, behavioral health, adapted sports, adventure therapy, or youth development is desired.
