

## **Assistant Professor (Non-Tenure Track) of Marine and Environmental Sciences**

The Stokes School of Marine and Environmental Sciences at the University of South Alabama (USA) (<https://www.southalabama.edu/colleges/artsandsci/marinesciences/>) seeks applicants for a full-time (12-month), non-tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor to serve as **Research Coordinator for the Weeks Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve (Weeks Bay NERR)**.

This position is based at Weeks Bay NERR in Fairhope, Alabama, and represents a collaborative partnership between USA and the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (ADCNR), State Lands Division.

The position will oversee research and monitoring activities for the Weeks Bay NERR, initiate research projects, and facilitate research activities from academic, governmental, non-profit and private research organizations partnering with the Reserve. This is a professional position, requiring a background in field research and expertise in estuarine ecology, including experience in at least one of the Reserve System Priority Research Areas: improved water quality through reduction of pollution, better stormwater management, improved land conservation and management practices, increased protection of water resources, increased coastal resilience and disaster response, and adaptation to weather/storm impacts.

A Ph.D. in estuarine ecology, resource management, environmental sciences, coastal / marine sciences, or other related fields is required.
