The University of South Alabama Department of Psychology invites applications for a full-time (9-month), tenure-track position in Clinical or Counseling Psychology at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor, beginning on August 15, 2022. Candidates should hold a doctoral degree, have completed an internship from an APA-accredited program, and must be licensed as a Psychologist in the State of Alabama or must be license-eligible and receive the license within the first year of employment. ABD candidates will be considered for the rank of Assistant Professor, but an earned doctoral degree is required prior to August 15, 2022. Candidates at the level of Associate Professor must provide evidence of an established research agenda appropriate to that rank. Additionally at that rank, significant clinical and clinical supervision experience is preferred. We have a unique APA-accredited doctoral program that combines clinical and counseling psychology (CCP), using a combined-integrated model (for more details, see CCP program website at <https://www.southalabama.edu/colleges/graduateschool/ccp/>). We emphasize science-practice integration and promoting culturally competent clinical practice. Other priority areas in our CCP program include injury prevention, trauma and resilience, and community engagement. Area of specialization is open for this position, but preference will be given to candidates with expertise in substance abuse, pediatric/child psychology, or behavioral health. The ability to strengthen partnerships with the USA College of Medicine and community organizations is highly valued. The successful candidate for this tenure-track position will be expected to maintain an active research program and mentor students in our Ph.D. and undergraduate programs. Additionally, opportunities exist for taking the administrative role of Clinic Director of the USA Psychological Clinic, making this an attractive position for candidates with a clinical training and supervision focus.

The University of South Alabama is located in Mobile, Alabama, on the Gulf of Mexico, and has an attached medical school and affiliated healthcare system. Roughly 500,000 persons reside within a 25-mile radius of downtown Mobile. We are ethnically diverse, attracting students from all over the world. The region features a moderate maritime climate, a modest cost of living, and ample recreational opportunities.
