Who is eligible to enroll?

- High School Senior

- Unofficial or official ACT scores required
- 3.0 GPA
- Transcripts
- Written approval from high school principal

- Automatic Enrollment (See Start South for details)
- Priority housing as entering freshman
- Earn credit towards any engineering degree
- Reduce cost to degree
