


## Welcome to Degree Works!


Run your degree evaluation through your secure PAWS login <https://paws.southalabama.edu>  
**Student Services & Financial Aid** → **Student Records** → **Degree Audit (Evaluation)**

This will automatically take you to the **Worksheets** screen and your degree audit.

Your degree audit lists your degree requirements and courses you have taken to fulfill those requirements.

 = requirements complete

 = requirements not complete and course options for completion are listed next to the requirement

 = requirement will be complete once the in-progress courses are completed and passed

Please note, catalog years prior to 2012-2013 are not available in Degree Works; however, you can still use the other functions of Degree Works listed below. Please contact your academic advisor for information regarding degree requirements for catalogs prior to 2012-2013.

**What-If** – Degree Works allows you to see how changing your current academic program (adding/deleting/changing majors, minors, etc.) will affect your degree progress.

- Select a **Degree** → select a **Catalog Year** → select a **Major** → select a **Minor** and/or **Concentration**, if applicable
- You may also add classes planned for the future.
- To review the results you can select the Process What-If tab to preview output in full screen view or Print/Save PDF to print output or save as a PDF.

**Look Ahead** – The Look Ahead feature allows you to enter courses to see how they will be applied towards fulfilling your degree requirements

- Enter Subject and Course Number → select Add Course → Process New
- The course(s) entered will display on your degree audit as PLAN allowing you to determine if the course(s) will fulfill degree requirements

**Class History** – Click on the **Class History** link to view a chronological list of your complete academic history, including all applicable transfer courses.

**GPA Calculators** – There are three different GPA calculators: Graduation, Term, and Advice Calculators. Select the **GPA Calc** tab to access the GPA calculators and select the type of calculator you wish to use.

The **Graduation Calculator** will give a general view of what average GPA you will need to achieve over your final required credits to achieve your desired GPA. Your Current GPA is listed by default.

- Enter the credits remaining → total credits required for your degree → your desired GPA → Calculate
- Select the Recalculate button to recalculate GPA with different data.

The **Term Calculator** allows you to calculate a future GPA based on currently enrolled classes. Your current classes are preloaded.

- Select the grade you are expecting to receive for each class from the drop down box
- You may add additional classes by inputting credit hours and expected grade
- Select Calculate and you will be able to view an updated GPA based on the grades you entered
- Select Recalculate to calculate the GPA with different data

The **Advice Calculator** is used to figure out how you can raise/lower your GPA using actual grades as advice.

- Input your desired GPA → Calculate
- To recalculate using a different desired GPA select Recalculate

The GPA Calculators will omit results that would require you to take more than 150 credits. It will also advise when a desired GPA is not possible or not realistic due to the required number of credits needed to achieve.
