Dear Colleagues:

For FY 2017, the University received a total of \$56,985,147 in externally sponsored awards. The *Annual Report for FY 2017* is produced by the Office of Research and Economic Development and details externally-funded activity, clinical trials, and intellectual property activity. Additionally, the *Annual Report for FY 2017* also includes a report detailing research expenditures for FY 2017, provided by the Division of Finance and Administration, and a record of awarded investigators which credits both principal investigators and co-investigators who received funding.

Gross licensing revenues received in FY 2017 are reported by the Office of Intellectual Property Management and total \$2,530,127. The larger portion of this revenue was attributable to a license agreement between the South Alabama Medical Science Foundation and a subsidiary of Merck KGaA. Other key statistics include thirty-six (36) invention disclosures submitted, eighteen (18) U.S. patents filed, four (4) U.S. patents issued, and three (3) license/option agreements executed.

We very much appreciate working with our USA researchers and scholars to be strong partners in the advancement of fundamental and translational research at the University of South Alabama.


BY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2017






BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2017


BY FUNDING PURPOSE FISCAL YEAR 2017




